## July 2018: Supplementary Local Rules:

- 1. Par-3 holes Nos 2 & 5 are 'call-up' holes. When your match is on the green, please mark your balls and invite the following match to tee-off if it is waiting on the tee. Once the tee shots are taken, please resume putting-out. Following match: please be prepared to be called up!
- 2. Mole-plough cracks: if your <u>ball comes to rest in</u> a mole-plough crack 'through the green', relief may be taken without penalty drop within 6 inches of nearest point of relief.

N.B: No relief for stance or line-of-sight etc.

## **Please Note Also:**

G.U.R 12<sup>th</sup> hole – the area to the right on approach to the green, (where blackthorn bushes have been removed opposite 13<sup>th</sup> tee), is no longer G.U.R. Any poor lie for a ball coming to rest in this area is deemed 'rub-of-the-green' (and no different to being in the bushes prior to their removal).

White Lines - e.g. on approach to a green (indicating limit for trollies or buggies). No relief for a ball resting on, or in any depression under the line. This is deemed 'rub-of-the-green'.
