The Game :-

4 Person Team - Florida Scramble is a golf game that is a twist on a basic Texas scramble. Each player plays from the teeing area on each hole, one of the tee shots is then selected. The spot where the ball came to rest is marked. The person whose shot has been selected then skips the next shot, all the rest of the players play their second shots from that spot. After that until the ball is holed, the golfer whose shot is selected, skips the next shot.

3 Person Team – plays Texas scramble format. Each player plays from the teeing area on each hole, one of the tee shots is then selected and all the players play their second shots from that spot. One of the second shots is then selected, and all players play their third shots from that spot, and so on until the ball is holed.

Number of drives:-

4 person team must have a minimum of 4 drives.

3 person team must have a minimum of 5 drives.
